#### Possible Reconsideration and Work Session

SB 490 A

Modifies definition of "exempt prohibited individual." Prohibits permanently from providing child care individuals who have been subject of substantiated report of child abuse in which victim suffered serious harm or death and individuals who are required to report as sex offenders.

*Please note: SB 490 A is being scheduled for reconsideration for the purpose of adding a subsequent referral to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.*

#### Possible Work Session

SB 534 A

Requires local governments to allow single-family dwellings within urban growth boundary of city with population greater than 25,000 in residential lots platted and zoned for such uses.

*Please note: SB 534 A is being scheduled for a work session solely to move it without recommendation to the House Committee on Rules.*

SB 586 A

Renames "Office of Manufactured Dwelling Park Community Relations" to "Manufactured and Marina Communities Division" and "Mobile Home Parks Account" to "Manufactured and Marina Communities Account." Extends division's duties and account's uses to marinas and floating home tenants.
