Public Hearing

- HB 2241 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Authorizes Chief Justice of the Supreme Court to impose fees on public bodies for use of certain electronic court services.
- HB 2462
Directs court to, at time of arraignment, notify defendant that status as servicemember may make defendant eligible for treatment programs, specialty courts or sentencing mitigation.
- HB 2585
Allows Chief Medical Examiner to complete and file report of death for person missing in wilderness and presumed dead.
- HB 2598
Permits creation of noncharitable business purpose trust.

Work Session

- HB 2239 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Increases number of circuit court judges in certain judicial districts.
- HB 2328 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Modifies culpable mental state for crime of unauthorized use of a vehicle when person takes, operates, exercises control over or otherwise uses vehicle, boat or aircraft without consent of owner.
- HB 3006
Modifies procedures for probate of estate with no known assets.
- HB 3007
Modifies provisions relating to small estates.
- HB 3008
Requires approval by probate court of settlement of personal injury claim or wrongful death claim arising out of injuries to decedent.
