#### Public Hearing

- HB 3005  
Modifies laws related to ignition interlock devices.
- HB 3338  
Prohibits police officers commissioned by public university from carrying firearms as police officers outside of police headquarters if public university is located in city with population exceeding 150,000.

#### Work Session

- HB 2347  
Clarifies that current safety belt exemption for delivering newspapers or mail applies to person driving route to deliver newspapers or mail.
- HB 2471  
Provides that, in prosecutions for violation of city motor vehicle parking ordinances, defendant may not be required to pay fine or bail amount before requesting hearing or submitting explanation to court.
- HB 3064 \*\*  
Expands membership of Justice Reinvestment Program Grant Review Committee. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- HB 2472  
Directs Health Licensing Office to register qualified applicant as sexual offense therapist intern.
- HB 2328 \*\*  
CARRIED OVER FROM 3/19/2019 AGENDA: Modifies culpable mental state for crime of unauthorized use of a vehicle when person takes, operates, exercises control over or otherwise uses vehicle, boat or aircraft without consent of owner. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
