HB 2431

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 03/25/2019 AGENDA: Requires each state agency to report to Attorney General, Public Records Advocate and public records subcommittee of Legislative Counsel Committee on number of public records requests received during preceding year, and number of those requests still outstanding after specified periods of time.

Public Hearing

HB 2474

Excludes subpoenas issued by district attorneys for grand juries from certain notice, content and procedural requirements applicable to summonses and subpoenas issued to financial institutions for financial records of customers.

HB 3145

Directs Public Defense Services Commission to conduct study on improving provision of public defense services and present report on findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to judiciary on or before September 15, 2020.

HB 3281

Requires Oregon Health Authority to research, study and compare behavioral health treatment in other states and report findings to appropriate interim committees of Legislative Assembly no later than September 15, 2020.
