Public Hearing and Work Session

- SB 185 A
Prohibits person licensed to distribute cigarettes or tobacco products from affixing Oregon tax stamps or purchasing untaxed roll-your-own tobacco unless person certifies to Attorney General that cigarettes or tobacco was purchased directly from manufacturer or importer.
- SB 358 A
Removes provisions prohibiting Oregon State Bar from charging membership fees to members admitted to practice law for 50 years or more.
- SB 359
Provides structure and procedures by which business corporation and nonprofit corporation may ratify and approve defective corporate actions.
- SB 684 A
Specifies requirements for covered entities that own, license, maintain, store, manage, collect, process, acquire or otherwise possess personal information, and for vendors that provide services to covered entities, to notify consumers of breach of security.

Work Session

- SB 31 A
Permits Oregon Public Guardian and Conservator to establish county, regional and statewide high-risk teams to identify options available for addressing safety risks facing highly vulnerable adults.
- SB 360 A
Updates laws that govern nonprofit corporations in this state.
