#### **Public Hearing**

SB 15 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/6/19 AGENDA: Authorizes Youth Development Division to inspect and collect data from facilities in which juveniles are detained to ensure compliance with federal Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act.

SB 269 A

Directs Department of Corrections to provide audit report prescribed by Prison Rape Elimination Act of 2003 to Legislative Assembly no later than February 1 following completion of audit report.

SB 576 A

Imposes certain requirements related to private security providers who contract with or are employed by institutions of higher education to provide private security services on campus and special campus security officers commissioned by governing boards of public universities.

SB 924 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/6/19 AGENDA: Modifies juvenile code to prohibit placement of children and wards taken into protective custody in detention facilities.

SB 1011 A

Provides that obligee spouse's conviction for attempted murder or conspiracy to commit murder of obligor spouse is change of circumstances for purposes of spousal support modification.
