- HB 2923
Classifies certain persons as resident persons for purpose of purchasing licenses, tags and permits issued by State Fish and Wildlife Commission.
- HB 3168
Authorizes operation of boats propelled by electric motors on named lakes and waters of this state under certain circumstances.
- HB 3227 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes Excessive Elk Damage Pilot Program.

Work Session

- HB 2351
Authorizes State Marine Board to adopt special regulations to protect shoreline in Willamette River Greenway.
- HB 2352
Creates towed watersports program within State Marine Board.
- HB 2834 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires State Department of Fish and Wildlife, in consultation with Department of Transportation, to develop Wildlife Corridor and Safe Road Crossing Action Plan for use by state agencies.
- HB 2829 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes Oregon Conservation and Recreation Fund.
- HB 2979 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Appropriates moneys to Oregon Department of Administrative Services for distribution to Association of Oregon Counties to contract for provision of technical assistance and information to landowners for complying with certain requirements related to replacement or repair of tide gates with opening size of four feet or smaller.
