Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 2085
Regulates construction and removal of dams.
- HB 2331
Provides that Water Resources Commission has certain amount of time to enforce general or special standards related to well construction activities.
- HB 3025
Requires State Forestry Department to establish Western Oregon Regional Carbon Sink as geographical area and take certain actions regarding area on or before January 1, 2031.
- HB 3309
Directs State Department of Geology and Mineral Industries to study and make recommendations on provisions of state law related to geological and mineral resources of state.
- HB 2113
Requires State Department of Fish and Wildlife to develop and implement program to provide Oregon businesses, communities and landowners with technical assistance regarding nonlethal methods to reduce conflict between humans and wildlife.
- HB 2795
Directs State Department of Fish and Wildlife to create pilot program that allows persons to use dogs for hunting, or nonlethal pursuit of, cougars within county electing to participate in pilot-program.
- HB 3118
Authorizes State Department of Fish and Wildlife use of appointed agents for purposes of cougar management.
- HB 3119
Requires State Department of Fish and Wildlife to designate overseeing employee if department operates cougar management plan that uses appointed agents.
