Work Session

SB 431 B

Creates urban flood safety and water quality district in portion of Multnomah County within urban growth boundary adopted by Metro, for purposes of acquiring, purchasing, constructing, improving, operating and maintaining infrastructure in order to provide for flood safety and contribute to water quality, floodplain restoration and habitat and landscape resilience.

SB 1045 A

Authorizes city or county to adopt property tax exemption in amount not to exceed \$300,000 of assessed value of principal place of residence used by homeowner to rent space in residence through public or nonprofit home share program to individuals seeking such space.

SB 212 A

(For Purposes of considering Amendment that Replaces Bill) Disallows, for personal income or corporate excise tax purposes, deduction for losses from wagering transactions.
