#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 3419  
Prohibits prosecuting attorney from conditioning plea offer on waiver of specified rights, eligibilities and legal challenges.
- SB 731  
Authorizes recognized student government of community college or public university, or member of recognized student government, to make statement or issue resolution to promote or oppose gathering of signatures on initiative or referendum petition or adoption of ballot measure.
- SB 870  
Enacts Interstate Compact for Agreement Among the States to Elect the President by National Popular Vote.

#### Possible Work Session

- HB 3431  
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5-16-2019 AGENDA: Limits definition of "public building" or "property" to exclude convention or exposition centers, zoos, performing arts centers or other venues or attractions dedicated to tourism, travel, hospitality or entertainment for purposes of management by persons who are blind.
- SB 72 A  
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5-16-2019 AGENDA: Eliminates certain duties of Oregon Department of Administrative Services and other state agencies related to tracking and reporting of travel awards earned as part of official state business.
- SB 471 A  
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5-16-2019 AGENDA: Requires prospective contractor to state in bid or proposal for public contract whether and extent to which prospective contractor will use conflict minerals in performing public contract and whether prospective contractor's disclosures, policies, practices and procedures with respect to procuring conflict minerals comply with Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development's Due Diligence Guidance for Responsible Supply Chains of Minerals from Conflict-Affected and High-Risk Areas.
