#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 234 A  
Removes exclusion of students receiving federal vocational rehabilitation education benefits from section providing for resident rate tuition at public universities and community colleges for students who served, or who are dependents of someone who served, in Armed Forces or international position.
- SB 462  
Provides that person who served in United States Naval Construction Force, or "Seabees," is eligible to receive veterans' recognition registration plate.
- SB 528  
Directs Department of Transportation to erect and maintain roadside memorial signs for firefighters killed in line of duty.
- SCR 2  
Recognizes and honors Corporal Jimmy Erik Floren (1946-1967) for his service to his country.
- SCR 3  
Recognizes and honors Radarman 2nd Class Garry Bradbury Hodgson (1937-1969) for his service to his country.
- SCR 29 A  
Recognizes and honors Sheriff Glenn A. Shipman (1927-2016) for his service to his nation, state and community.
