Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 3127
Requires Oregon Government Ethics Commission to receive written findings of fact prepared by investigator directed by Legislative Assembly or legislative rule to determine whether lobbyist engaged in conduct prohibited under legislative branch personnel rules.
- HB 3377
Directs Legislative Assembly to study issues relating to safe and respectful workplace in State Capitol.
- HCR 20
Establishes standards of conduct applicable to Legislative Branch and other persons present in State Capitol.
- HCR 26
Establishes standards of conduct applicable to Legislative Branch and lobbyists.
