#### Public Hearing

- SB 56  
Eliminates motor carrier weight receipts.
- SB 1033  
Provides that registered owner may request that registration card issued for vehicle include information that owner, or person operating vehicle, may be deaf or hard of hearing.
- SB 1044  
Establishes goals that promote zero-emission vehicle use and requires entities of executive department to promote zero-emission vehicle use.
- HB 3111  
Modifies provisions for reimbursement to administrator of electric vehicle rebates issued to recipients that sell vehicle or terminate lease before 24 months after purchase or beginning of lease.

#### Work Session

- HB 2129 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue  
Extends and creates sunsets for certain transportation-related tax expenditures.
- HB 3214  
Allows person with hardship driver permit to provide necessary services to person or member of person's family.
- HB 3418  
Provides that portion of McKenzie Highway shall also be known as Johnny Miner Memorial Highway.
- SB 411  
Directs Department of Transportation to prepare report on maximum weight limits of vehicles powered by electricity and submit report to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to transportation on or before September 15, 2020.
- HJM 1  
Urges President and Congress to pursue Oregon and California Railroad grant land management reforms.
