Possible Introduction of Committee Measures

- SB 43
Authorizes State Board of Geologist Examiners to adopt rules prescribing continuing education requirements.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 294
Authorizes annexation of land to pioneer cemetery maintenance district upon petition by owner and approval of governing body of district.
- SB 298
Allows employee or agent of funeral home or person acting as funeral service practitioner named in record of death or fetal death to request certified copy of record of death or fetal death at any time following date of death.
- SB 76
Authorizes Oregon Racing Commission to issue exchange wagering license to qualified applicant.
- SB 77
Allows Oregon Racing Commission to adopt rules to authorize and license Multi-Jurisdictional Simulcasting and Interactive Wagering Totalizator Hubs to conduct simulcast broadcasting of, and mutuel wagering on, animal races.
- SB 78
Directs Oregon Racing Commission to adopt rules related to issuance of licenses to conduct off-race course simulcast mutuel wagering.
- SB 251
Updates various statutes in Insurance Code to reflect changes in National Association of Insurance Commissioners model provisions related to reducing reserve requirements for domestic ceding insurers that cede insurance to reinsurers and to regulating insurance adjusters and insurance consultants.
