Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 3061
Allows political subdivision to convey real property to nonprofit, municipal or private corporation for purpose of providing broadband service.
- HB 2243
Defines "public library" as public facility providing free and equal access to library and information services for all residents of local government unit.
- HB 2094 A
Permits contracting agency to consider at any time before executing public contract with bidder or proposer whether bidder or proposer owes liquidated or delinquent debt to state.
- HB 3113 A
Increases number of premises at which winery licensee may import, process, store and export wine or cider and sell malt beverages, wine and cider under single license.
- HB 2419 A
Permits Department of Consumer and Business Services to issue licenses and conduct criminal records checks through Nationwide Multistate Licensing System.

Note change: HB 3065 has been removed. HB 3113 and HB 2419 have been added.
