#### Possible Reconsideration and Work Session

HB 2486

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 04/30/2019 AGENDA: Allows Real Estate Agency to electronically facilitate condominium reporting process.

#### Work Session

HB 2243

Defines "public library" as public facility providing free and equal access to library and information services for all residents of local government unit.

#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 3239

Removes limit on number of full on-premises sales licenses that distillery licensee may hold.

HB 3116 A

Requires counties with population of 650,000 or more to use proceeds from sale of foreclosed property to reimburse municipal liens against property for utilities improvements or seismic rehabilitation.

HB 3200

Requires applicant for marijuana production license that does not own premises at which marijuana will be produced to submit signed informed consent of owner of premises to Oregon Liquor Control Commission.

HB 2098 A

Directs Oregon Liquor Control Commission to establish advisory committee to advise commission, Oregon Health Authority and State Department of Agriculture on standards for testing marijuana.
