- SB 16
Specifies types of licensed health care practitioners authorized to perform assessments or examinations for purposes of determining special education services eligibility.
- SB 486
Establishes timelines by which evaluations must be completed to determine eligibility for special education.
- SB 719 **
Directs Department of Education to conduct evaluation and administer pilot program related to abbreviated school day programs. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Student Success then to Ways and Means
