- SB 255 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Higher Education Coordinating Commission for Oregon Institute of Marine Biology at University of Oregon.
- SB 257 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Higher Education Coordinating Commission for agricultural experiment station and branch stations, Oregon State University Extension Service and Forest Research Laboratory programs of Oregon State University.
- SB 690 A
Repeals sunset provision for Interstate Compact on Educational Opportunity for Military Children.
- SB 739 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Student Success then to Ways and Means
Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Higher Education Coordinating Commission for distribution to University of Oregon for program that strives to improve high school graduation rates through collaborative partnerships between university faculty and high school teachers.
- SB 794 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires Higher Education Coordinating Commission to design question allowing each student to identify whether student is parent that will be placed on all forms used to collect demographic information by public post-secondary institutions of education.
- SB 802 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Student Success then to Ways and Means
Allows military child to be considered resident of school district for purposes of enrollment and class placement based on official military order for transfer of parent of child.

Public Hearing

- SB 692 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Student Success then to Ways and Means
Directs Youth Development Division to develop and administer statewide youth reengagement system.
- SB 665
Directs State Board of Education to adopt rules for administration of naloxone or any similar medication designed to rapidly reverse overdose of opioid drug.

- SB 801 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Judiciary
Authorizes public schools to provide firearm safety and accident prevention class to all students in first grade.
- SB 282 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires Department of Education, in cooperation with Oregon Health Authority, to conduct study to determine and recommend appropriate health standards to govern student use of computers, mobile digital devices and other electronic media in classrooms.
- SB 283 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs Department of Education to prepare and make available statement that discloses potential health risks of wireless network technology and requires public and private schools to distribute statement to employees, students and parents or guardians of students.
