SB 193

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3-26-2019 MEETING Provides that interstate broadcaster's market for sales, used in determination of receipts factor in apportionment formula for corporate excise tax, is in state if customer's corporate domicile is in state or if individual customer is resident of state.

SB 393 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3-26-2019 MEETING Authorizes translator districts to annex cities where cable television corporations operate or have ceased operations and city electors approve annexation.
