Possible Introduction of Committee Measures

- SB 889  
CARRIED OVER FROM 03/25/2019 AGENDA: Establishes Health Care Cost Growth Benchmark program to control growth of health care expenditures in this state.
- SB 134  
CARRIED OVER FROM 03/25/2019 AGENDA: Requires coordinated care organizations to develop standardized system of care to use when assessing individuals.
- SB 130  
Authorizes school nurse associated with school-based health center to engage in practice of telehealth.
- SB 140  
Establishes Emergency Department Boarding Pilot Project in Oregon Health Authority.
- SB 734  
Requires individual and group health insurance policies to reimburse services provided by naturopathic physicians within scope of their practice if services are reimbursed when provided by licensed physicians.
- SB 911 \*\*  
Requires health benefit plans, state medical assistance program, Public Employees' Benefit Board and Oregon Educators Benefit Board to pay for standard fertility preservation services for covered individual who will undergo medical treatment that is likely to result in iatrogenic infertility. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 62  
Prohibits employing person that employer knows, or with exercise of reasonable care should know, is not licensed or permitted to practice medical imaging modality.
- SB 63  
Directs Board of Medical Imaging to adopt rules related to temporary permits for limited X-ray machine operators.

- SB 250  
Adopts Fry Graph Readability Formula for health insurance policies and materials approved by Department of Consumer and Business Services.
- SB 179  
Requires Department of Human Services to administer palliative care pilot project to support provision of community-based end of life care.
- SB 588  
Establishes Outdoor Therapy Grant Program within State Parks and Recreation Department for purpose of awarding grants to enhance outdoor environmental, ecological, agricultural or other natural resource-based therapy programs serving residents of this state.
- SB 721  
Requires coordinated care organization to reimburse cost of services provided by school-based health centers to members of coordinated care organization at rate paid to in-network providers.
- SB 887  
Requires insurer, Public Employees' Benefit Board and Oregon Educators Benefit Board to cover specified health services without prior authorization in health benefit plans and benefit plans offered by insurer or board.
- SB 941 \*\*  
Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Department of Administrative Services for distribution to Curry Health District for purposes of acquiring ambulance for maternity care and opening emergency room in Curry Medical Center. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
