- HB 2037
Allows Public Employees' Benefit Board and Oregon Educators Benefit Board to make available long term care insurance plans at boards' discretion rather than as statutory requirement.
- HB 2040 A
Adds two members to Traditional Health Workers Commission.
- HB 2563 A
Establishes Newborn Bloodspot Screening Advisory Board in Oregon Health Authority.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 2185 A
Imposes new requirements on pharmacy benefit managers registered in this state.
- HB 2692 A
Requires Pharmacy and Therapeutics Committee to publish on website of Oregon Health Authority within seven days recommendations concerning Practitioner-Managed Prescription Drug Plan.
