Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

SB 19

Requires Department of Human Services and Oregon Health Authority to adopt rules for licensing of each type of adult foster home, including those providing residential care to older adults, persons with physical disabilities, persons with intellectual disabilities and persons with mental illness.

SB 20

Consolidates eligibility for services to children and adults with developmental disabilities.

SB 274

Expands eligibility for support service brokerage services to individuals who are 14 to 17 years of age.

SB 176 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Environment and Natural Resources CARRIED OVER FROM THE 02/26/2019 AGENDA: Requires certain filling stations, service stations, garages and other dispensaries that dispense Class 1 flammable liquids to provide equal access to persons with disabilities.

SB 31 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Judiciary CARRIED OVER FROM THE 02/26/2019 AGENDA: Permits Oregon Public Guardian and Conservator to establish county, regional and statewide high-risk teams to determine options available for addressing safety risks facing highly vulnerable adults.

SB 177 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Health Care

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 02/26/2019 AGENDA: Requires hospice program licensed by Oregon Health Authority to identify patients in need of palliative care, provide information to patients, residents and families of patients about palliative care and facilitate patient access to palliative care.

SB 491

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 02/26/2019 AGENDA: Transfers from Department of Human Services to Oregon Community Foundation responsibility for administering Fairview housing trust.

HB 2215

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 02/26/2019 AGENDA: Adds to rights of persons with mental illness committed to Oregon Health Authority, right to reasonable privacy and security in resting, sleeping, dressing, bathing, personal hygiene and toileting.

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 02/26/2019 AGENDA: Requires Department of Human Services to adopt by rule program that provides financial assistance to recipients of supplemental nutrition assistance for purchasing locally grown fruits and vegetables from participating farmers' markets, farm share sites and retail outlets.
