Public Hearing and Work Session

SB 25

Directs public bodies, and private entities in possession of relevant records, to comply, within specified time period, with court order for release of records to state mental hospital or other facility for purposes of forensic evaluation.

SB 184

Authorizes court to initiate commitment proceedings for extremely dangerous person with mental illness if court determines that there is no substantial probability that defendant will gain or regain fitness to proceed.

SB 375

Directs court to inform defendant of potential commitment or conditional discharge prior to accepting plea of guilty except for insanity.

SB 167

Aligns definitions in mental health services bill of rights with definitions applicable to reporting of abuse of persons with mental illness.

Work Session

SB 388

Directs Governor or designee to notify presiding judge of circuit court of county of conviction within 10 days of granting pardon.
