- SB 279
Requires certain persons that service student loans in this state to obtain or renew license.
- SB 685
Renames Law Enforcement Contacts Policy and Data Review Committee to Commission on Equity in Policing.
- SB 858
Allows any county governing body to enter into intergovernmental agreement with Judicial Department to provide law library services or enter into contract with law library association or corporation owning and maintaining law library convenient to courthouse for use by legal community.

Work Session

- SB 358
Removes provisions prohibiting Oregon State Bar from charging membership fees to members admitted to practice law for 50 years or more.
- SB 577 **
Directs Department of Justice to study topics relating to bias crimes and report results to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to judiciary on or before September 15, 2020. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- SB 783
Modifies requirement to notify Attorney General of elder abuse proceeding, making failure to notify not jurisdictional defect.
