#### Public Hearing and Work Session

- HB 2217 A  
Prohibits anyone other than patient from administering medication to end patient's life in humane and dignified manner.
- HB 3261 A  
Modifies requirement to record interview with person under 18 years of age to include custodial interviews conducted inside law enforcement facility by peace officer, school resource officer or special campus security officer of investigations into misdemeanors, felonies and acts that, if committed by adult, would constitute misdemeanors or felonies.

#### Work Session

- HB 2303 A  
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/8/2019 AGENDA: Allows pharmacist or pharmacy technician to transfer drug containing pseudoephedrine without prescription to person who is at least 18 years of age and presents person's valid government-issued photo identification.
- HB 2500 A  
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/8/2019 AGENDA: Provides private right of action to recover for expenses in relation to veterinary care for abused domestic animal.
- HB 3249 A  
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/8/2019 AGENDA: Provides that client has right to privately communicate with lawyer and representative of lawyer.
- HB 2598 A  
Permits creation of certain noncharitable business purpose trusts.
- HB 3006  
Modifies procedures for probate of estate with no known assets.
- HB 3007 A  
Modifies provisions relating to small estates.

HB 3008 A
