Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 2086 A
Revises definitions and harmonizes language for purposes of program supporting working land conservation.
- SB 451
Establishes eligibility for renewable energy certificates for facilities that generate electricity from direct combustion of municipal solid waste and became operational before January 1, 1995, if such facilities register with Western Renewable Energy Generation Information System at any time.
- SB 455
Requires public universities, community colleges and community college districts to require contractors to employ apprentices and to establish and execute plan for outreach, recruitment and retention of women and minority individuals for certain work relating to improvements to real property.
- SB 761
Requires that only elector who has personally printed copy of electronic signature sheet for petition or prospective petition may sign signature sheet.
- SB 854 A
Directs professional licensing boards, in certain circumstances, to accept individual taxpayer identification number or other federally-issued identification number in lieu of Social Security number on applications for issuance or renewal of authorization to practice occupation or profession.
- SB 855 A
Directs professional licensing boards to study manner in which persons who are immigrants or refugees become authorized to practice occupation or profession.
- SJM 5
Urges Congress to lead global effort to reduce threat of nuclear war.
- SJM 11
Urges Congress to require individual to disclose relevant portions of federal tax return to appear on ballot as candidate for federal elected office.
