Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 3022 A
Provides that diagnostic services are compensable under workers' compensation law after industrial accident or occupational disease has been determined to be compensable and if diagnostic services are reasonable and necessary to identify nature or extent of medical condition that may be related to industrial accident or occupational disease.
- HB 3431 A
Excludes vending facilities located at visitor venues from requirement that state grant to persons who are blind priority to operate vending facilities in public buildings.
- SB 10
Establishes permissible density requirements within urban growth boundaries of cities within metropolitan service district or with population more than 10,000 for areas adjacent to transportation corridors and zoned to allow residential development.

Possible Work Session

- HB 3076 A
Requires nonprofit hospitals and their nonprofit affiliated clinics to establish financial assistance policies meeting specified criteria, including reducing charges to low-income patients.
- SB 224
Removes requirement that county clerk move elector to inactive status if elector has neither voted nor updated registration for five or more years.
- SB 226
Permits minor political parties to choose to nominate candidates for particular offices as part of state-sponsored primary election.
- SJM 11
Urges Congress to require individual to disclose relevant portions of federal tax return to appear on ballot as candidate for federal elected office.
