Public Hearing SB 198 **

Extends sunset for tax credit for pension income.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

SB 164

Makes employer's failure to comply with requirements of Oregon Retirement Savings Plan unlawful practice.

Work Session

SB 75

Provides that interest earned by Employer Incentive Fund may be used to match lump sum payments by participating public employees Retirement System. 203 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Expenditures

SB 203 **

Extends sunset for earned income tax credit.

SB 758 **

Increases percentage of federal earned income credit allowable as credit against Oregon personal income tax. SB 243

Requires Department of Veterans' Affairs to conduct study to determine effects of employment discrimination against veterans on overall veteran unemployment rate in this state.

SB 519

Increases minimum wage exemption for purposes of garnishment and execution.

SB 722

Authorizes Director of Employment Department to prescribe rules that provide individual may not be excluded from being deemed unemployed solely because of service performed for employing unit under legal compulsion for which individual has not received pay on individual's regular payday.

Note change: the Public Hearing on SB 272 has been removed and Work Sessions on SB 75, SB 243, and SB 519 have been added.
