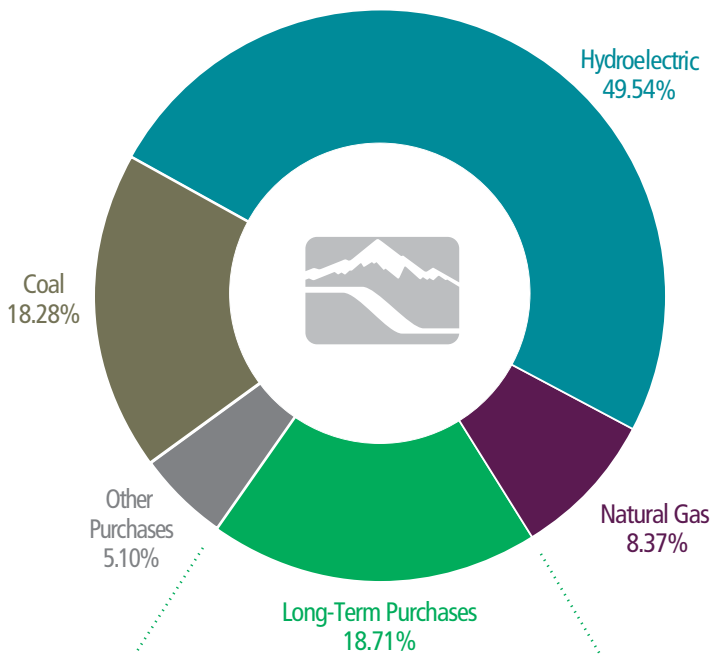


2017 Energy Portfolio

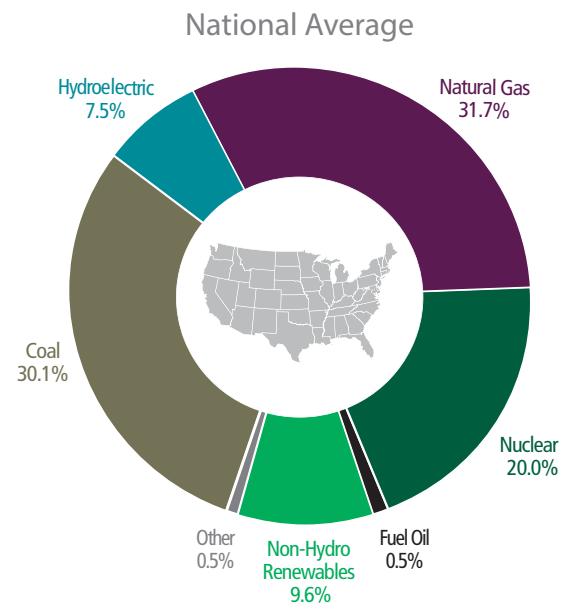
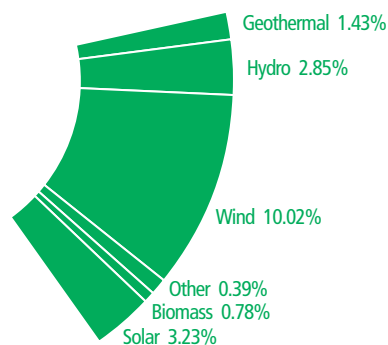


About our Long-term Purchases

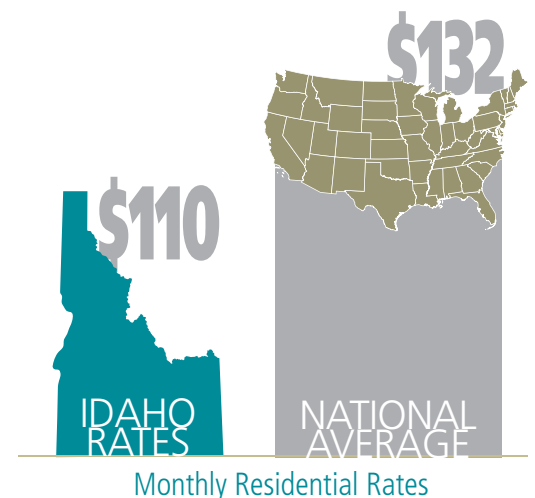
Idaho Power is committed to supporting renewable energy sources such as wind and solar, and we buy them as part of our portfolio mix. In turn, we sell the Renewable Energy Credits (RECs) we get from those purchases to offset power supply costs and keep customer prices as low as possible.

The buyer of the REC gets to claim that power as part of its energy. Therefore, we do not represent that electricity produced by this resource mix is being delivered to our retail customers. We do support these alternate energy sources, and we pass along that credit to the organizations that buy the RECs from us.
