OADC has consistently believed that the salaries for judges in Oregon need to be increased in order to attract the most qualified and talented members of the Bar to judicial positions. HB 2238, in tying State judge salaries to a designated percentage of Federal trial judges, makes good sense, and we believe would help to promote the judiciary and also advance the interests of the civil Bar.

OADC also supports the passage of HB 2239, which adds fourteen additional trial judges throughout the State. Not only would passage of this bill help to meet the timelines in child welfare cases; but also, it would help to relieve docket time and free up more judicial capacity for civil litigants.
