



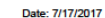

15 Years of Impact

- 797 aMW saved and generated—equal to powering 618,000 homes
- 57.9 million annual therms—equal to heating 114,000 homes
- \$7.6 billion in utility ratepayer savings over time
 - \$3.2 billion in participating customer bill savings
- \$6.7 billion added to the local economy
- 22.8 million tons of CO₂ avoided—equal to removing 4 million cars from Oregon roads

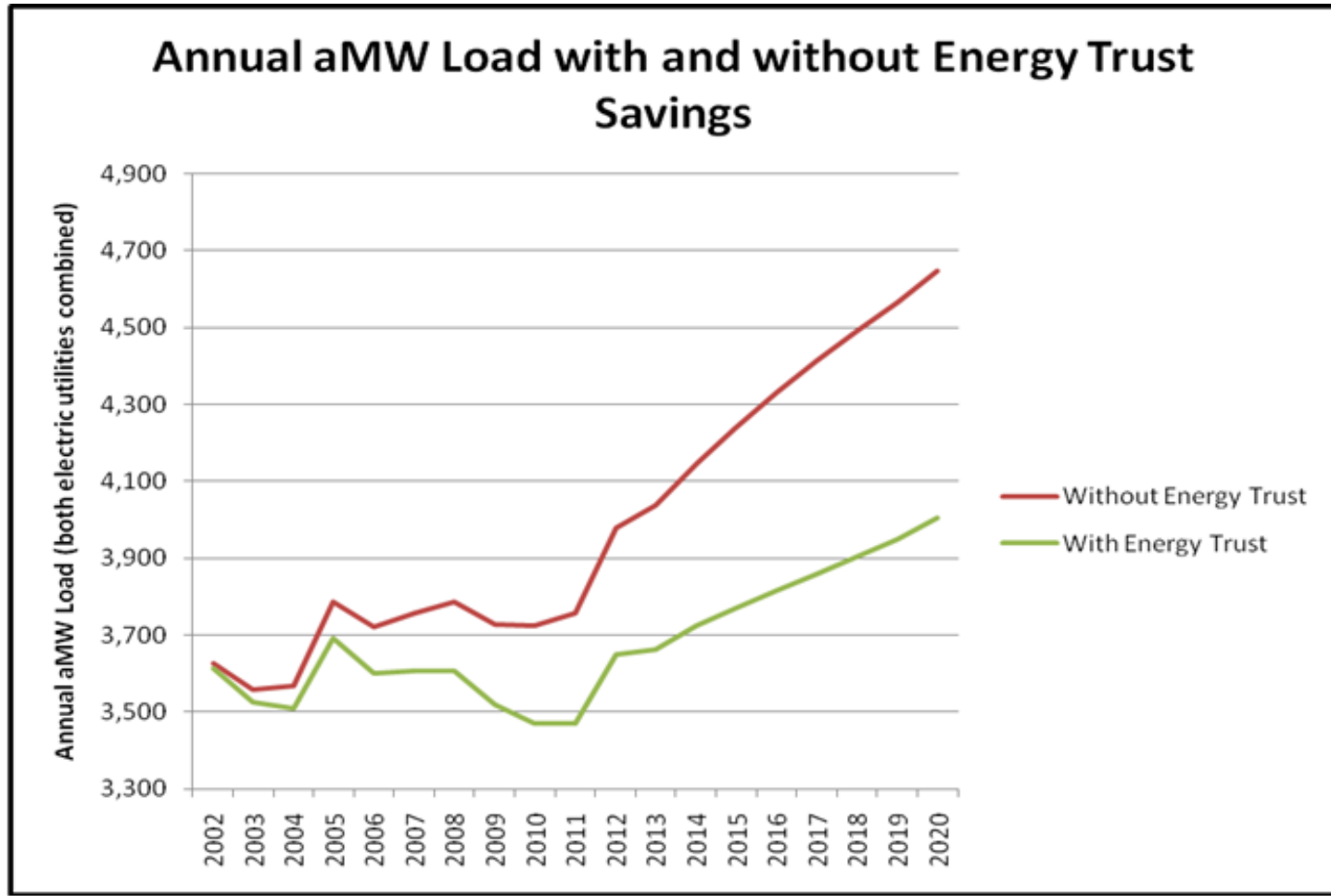

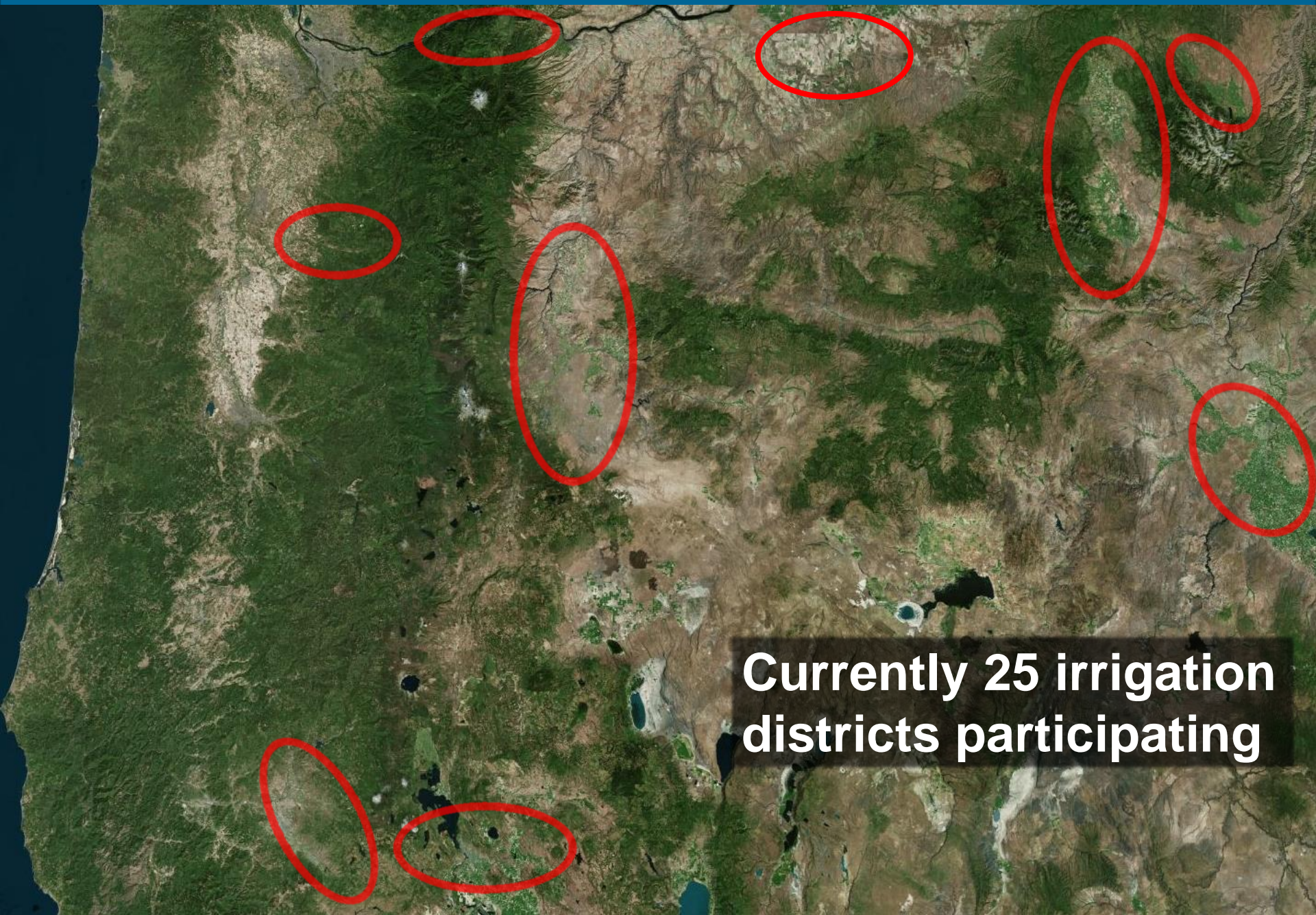
