


FINDINGs

- Complex bureaucracy, little oversight
- 2. Flat fee compensation
- 3. PDSC lacks independence
- 4. No authority over justice & municipal courts




Composition & Authority

- Independence: equal appointment by all three branches of government
- Commission should be 9 to 13 members
- No current judges, prosecutors, defense attorneys, law enforcement
- Diversity of constituencies represented on PDSC
- Broad standards-setting authority
- Oversight of <u>all</u> courts statewide

MIXED Public/Private SYSTEM

- Abolish fixed fee contracting
- Hourly rate: actual overhead
 - + reasonable fee
- Governmental public defender offices
