Chair Olsen, Vice Chair Monnes-Anderson and Committee Members,

As an Associate Member of the Vietnam Veterans of America, I come before you today with extreme homage for Marine Corporal Jimmy Floren. I did not serve, but, he did.

The text of SCR2 shares the story of a hero. This hero was decorated posthumously with a Purple Heart, the Navy Cross and the Silver Star.

The events of November 6, 1967 in Quang Nam Province, South Vietnam and the heroism of Corporal Floren should be memorialized and shared with future generations.

Benjamin Quen, a Klamath Falls resident, Chaplain for the Klamath Falls VFW Post and Marine Corps League Detachment, has stated his intent to do just that.
