Before the Joint Committee on Ways and Means Subcommittee on Natural Resources is HB 5002, the Oregon Department of Agriculture's (ODA) budget measure. I am writing to express my support.

ODA's mission of ensuring a healthy environment, natural resources and economy for all Oregonians is vital to the State's social, environmental and economic well-being. As a State Commodity Commission, each of these three areas are important to the viability of our success in global trade, I strongly urge the Subcommittee to support and fund the Agency's request for an additional international trade manager in the Agricultural Development and Marketing Program (ADMP) of the Market Access and Certification Program Area.

Oregon agricultural producers and processors produce more products than the state's citizens can consume. This necessitates the need for Oregon products to be sold across the country and around the world. The ODA's Agricultural Development and Marketing Program helps promote and create demand for Oregon's agricultural products domestically and internationally.
