Investments

- Provides \$13.7 million Other Funds expenditure limitation for the Modernization Project associated with updating and improving core systems within in the Unemployment Insurance program area
- Provides \$9.4 million in Other Funds expenditure limitation and 41 positions to assist with inter-agency contracts with the Department of Human Services
- Establishes permanent positions to work with the Trade Act and Foreign Labor Certification programs and Federal Funds expenditure limitation
- Updates the Department of Administrative Services Price
 List and State Government Services Charges
