Requires Oregon School for the Deaf serve children from zero through 20 years of age.

According to the Oregon School for the Deaf website, the school serves children from kindergarten through age 21. The school has three departments: elementary school, middle school, and high school. There is an adult transition program that serves students who have graduated from high school with modified diplomas that need assistance transitioning into independent living.
