**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:**

Eliminates requirement that certificate to practice cosmetology include the practitioner's address.

No revenue impact.

Minimal fiscal impact.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

**EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:**

The Oregon Health Licensing Office issues certificates to qualifying applicants who wish to provide cosmetology services to the public. These services include hair design, barbering, esthetics, nail technology, and natural hair care. Oregon administrative rule 817.035.0110 requires that the certificate be posted in public view. The certificate is statutorily required to include the practitioner's address. As a matter of safety and privacy, some practitioners are not comfortable having customers and the public know their home address.

House Bill 2749 eliminates the requirement that the certificate to practice cosmetology include the practitioner's address.
