And, now I'm living in my forever home. Living with my best friend, Sterling. I was lonely and let my DSPs know. They helped me move to this new home and I'm so happy. I would never have been able to do this without those guys that support me, DSPs.

It's hard when DSPs leave. I know everyone has to make a living. I would like my DSPs to stay with me. I'd like them to be paid enough to stay. The help I need is personal and it's hard when I have to start over with someone new.

If I didn't have DSPs to help, I would probably be in jail or the State Hospital or someplace worse. I have this great life now, I've worked hard to get it, but I could never have done this without a lot of help.
