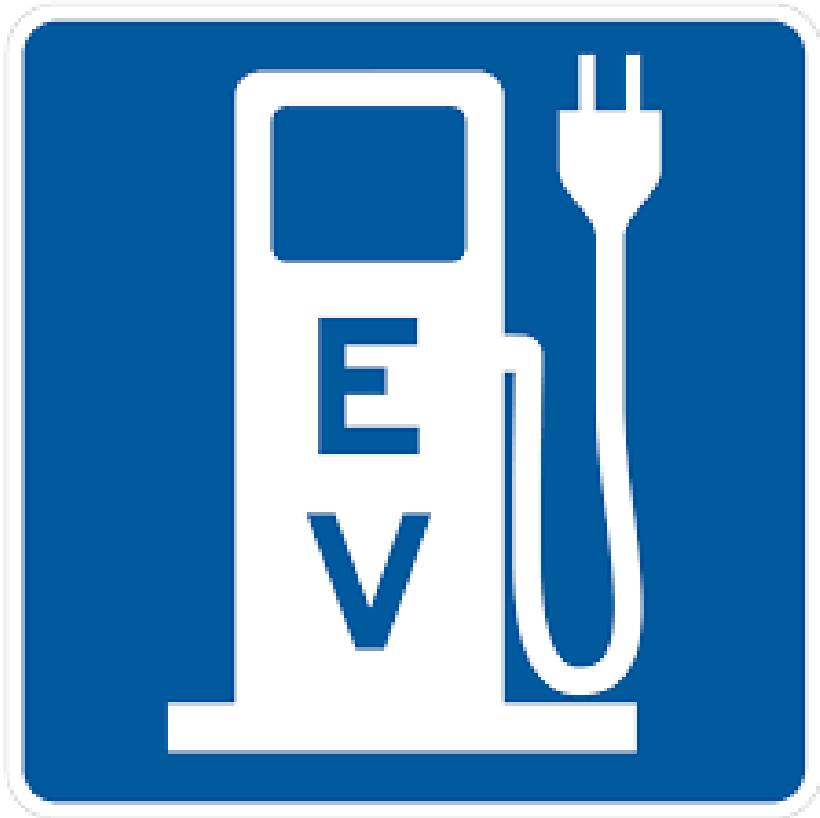

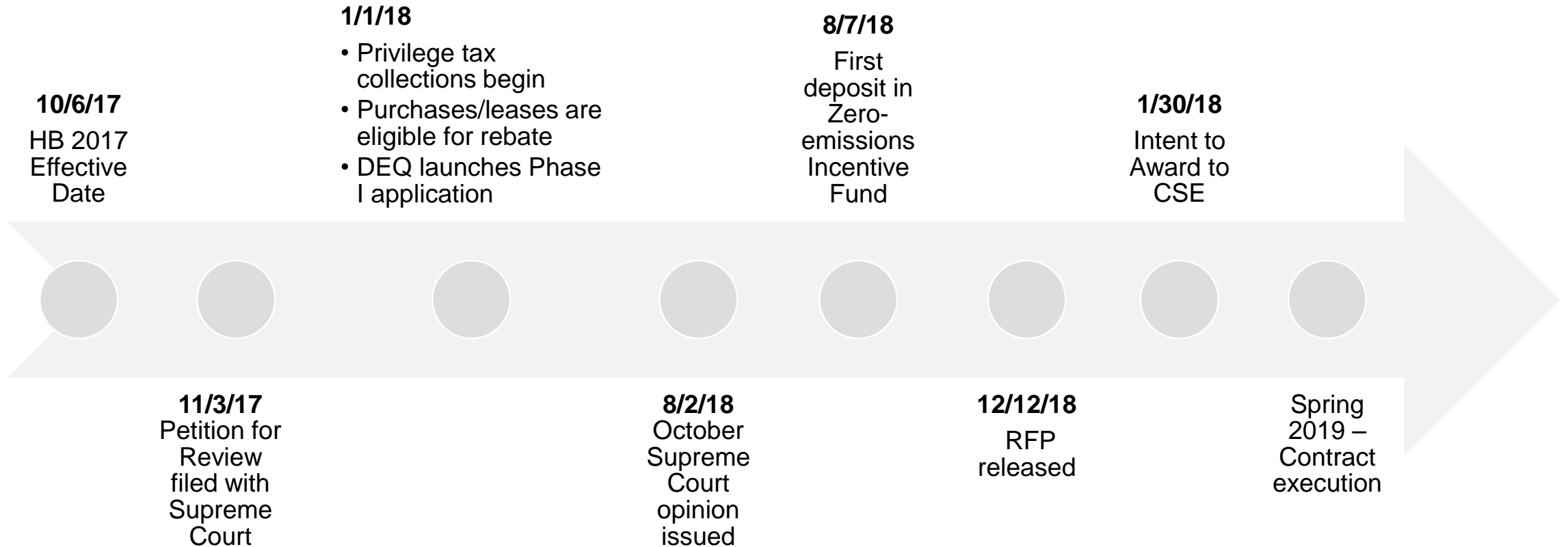

You may be eligible for the \$2,500 Charge Ahead Rebate if you:

1. Qualify as **low or moderate income household** based on your location and household size

2. Purchased or leased a new or used **battery-only** vehicle (plug-in hybrids are not eligible)

Charge Ahead income eligibility: Your household income must be less than 120% of the area median income for your closest **metropolitan statistical area**.

The information provided here is to help you determine whether or not you might be eligible for the Charge Ahead rebate. It does not guarantee that you will receive a rebate, as we will need additional information from you to verify eligibility.
