

**SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION**

**Legislative Fiscal Office  
Review of Semi-Independent Agency Reports**

On January 28th, the General Government Subcommittee recommended acknowledging receipt of a report from the Legislative Fiscal Office on its Review of Semi-Independent Agency Reports.

LFO is required to provide the Joint Committee on Ways and Means with a review of reports submitted by 12 semi-independent agencies pursuant to ORS 182.472. The review covers agency performance for the 2015-17 biennium, and the adopted budget for the 2017-19 biennium. LFO found that all 12 agencies submitted reports that complied with the statutory requirements. Included in the report are budget analyses, as well as operations and fund balance summaries for each agency. In addition, the LFO review recommends that all reporting agencies:

- 1) Continue to follow the updated reporting guidelines prepared by LFO for the 2020 reporting cycle.
- 2) Consider including candidates with financial expertise in their recommendations to the governor for board appointments.
- 3) Work in conjunction with other small licensing boards to develop a list of investigators available on contract for use across geographic regions.

The General Government Subcommittee recommends acknowledging receipt of the report and approval of the LFO recommendations.
