Chair Riley and members of the committee,

My name is Sunnie Day Sanchez and I am a Grow Site Administrator (GSA) for an OMMP grow site in Albany that was established post Measure 91. I had the opportunity to participate on an OHA RAC by providing input to OHA on rules relating to a GSA for the Cannabis Tracking System (CTS) and implementing SB 1544 that passed during the 2018 legislative session. I have been present as a citizen for most all of the Oregon Cannabis Commission meetings as well as many of the monthly OLCC Commissioner meetings.

I am in support of **SB 218 and the -1 and -2 amendments** and have been encouraging of more control on licensing since 2017. There have been two recent audits, one by the [Secretary of State](#) and one by [OLCC](#) in a legislative report of which both note that Oregon has a massive marijuana production oversupply.

I believe providing the OLCC with the resources they need to carry out the functions of the agency such as funding of an IT system should be a high priority this legislative session.

In addition, I am opposed to **SB 585** at this time.

I appreciate the opportunity to provide testimony to the Senate Committee on Business and General Government. Thank you for your time and consideration.

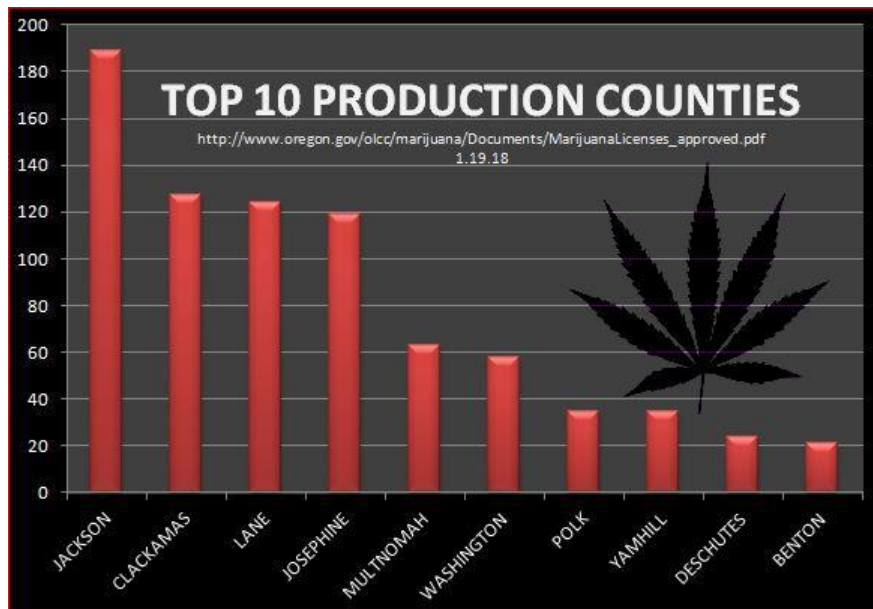

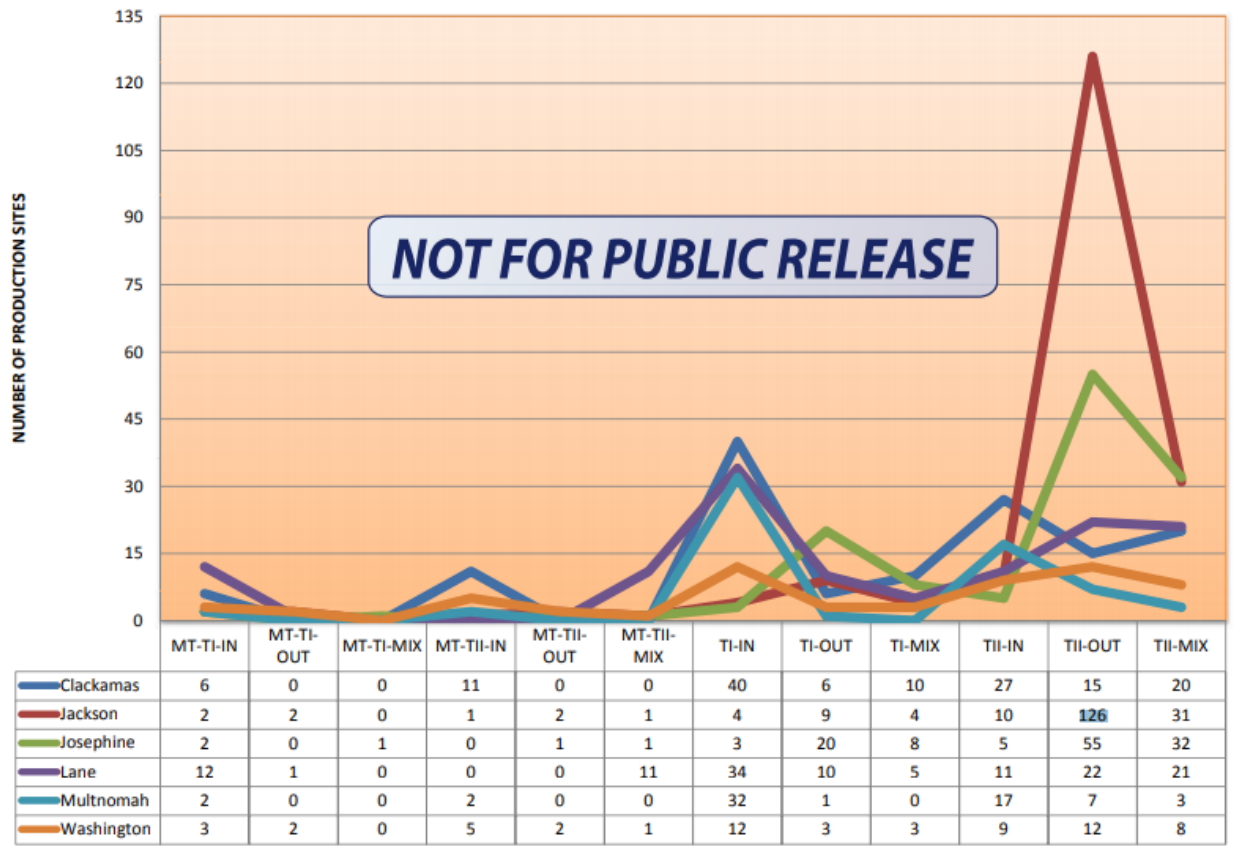
