Senate Bill 723 Lumps "all" activities

That take wildlife into the same category whether

it is a ODFW permitted and licensed activity

or not. ODFW regards pen raised birds

and privately owned birds as wildlife but only

after they are released. A permit is required

for release and a license is required for taking,

because ODFW defines hunting as "taking" therefore

a license is required.

ORS 498.106 Defines what we do for
recreation and enjoyment and is a lawful activity.

We have Two Labrador Retrievers. We raise,
train and love our dogs. We participate in AKC
(American Kennel Club) Hunt tests and Field Trials.
