I am imploring you to please defeat this bill. It is not only about a parents right but about a doctors right to treat their patients as needed.

I am a 59-year-old grandmother. I don't have a problem with vaccinations, my daughter doesn't have a problem with vaccinations, two of my grandchildren are vaccinated, one is not because she later had an allergic reaction and ended up in the hospital and almost died.
