To Co-Chairs Dembrow and Power and members of the committee regarding HB 2020

This proposed legislation is both personal and punitive to my person, my family, our community and our state.

It exercises a tax, in the form of an increase on rates for natural gas which will result in direct, substantial costs to all the above. It also raises our gas taxes to the point that it places Oregon in the absurd role of collecting the third highest fuels tax rates in the country.

Needless to say, such increases in the business sector can do only two things. They will, first and foremost, raise the cost of production in every sector of the business community. Is it not logical to assume that those entities will pass those increases on to the consumer ? Those increases will also be passed on to interstate customers, who, in an equally logical manner, find other suppliers...a lose/lose scenario by any measure.

HB 2020 places Oregon in the vanguard of an imagined world-wide assault on climate change.
