Use accurate carbon pricing figures if you are trying to evaluate carbon pricing. We must prepare for the climate crisis tipping point that is bearing down on us. We must address the largest polluters and not just nibble at the edges while we swoon over the possibility of offending insanely wealthy corporations. Yes, it is important if fuel prices go up but the impact of this in the short term pales in comparison to the devastation of uncontrolled climate damage in the long term.
