Measure Description:

Directs Department of Education to provide reimbursements for vision screenings of students to person that provided vision screening.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Analysis: This bill directs the Oregon Department of Education to provide reimbursements for vision screening of students to entity providing the vision screening and appropriates \$2.0 million General Fund to the Vision Health Account for reimbursements. Previously, educational institutions were reimbursed for screenings and then would reimburse the entity providing the service.

The General Fund will be used as a transfer to the Vision Health Fund. Given the statutory construction of the Fund, the same amount of Other Funds limitation is required to expend monies from the Fund.
