

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION

Measure: SB 128 - 2

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Measure Description:

Directs Board of Medical Imaging to issue permit to supervise fluoroscopy to qualified advanced practice registered nurse.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon State Board of Nursing (OSBN), Oregon Health Authority (OHA), Oregon Board of Medical Imaging (OBMI)

Summary of Fiscal Impact:

Costs related to the measure are anticipated to be minimal for the Oregon Board of Medical Imaging - See explanatory analysis.

This measure will have no fiscal impact on the Oregon Health Authority or the Oregon State Board of Nursing.

Analysis:

SB 128 - 2 directs the Oregon Board of Medical Imaging (OBMI) to issue a permit to allow qualified advanced practice registered nurses to supervise fluoroscopy. The measure allows OBMI to adopt rules to administer this permit.

New revenues from this permit will likely be derived from permit application and renewal fees, an examination fee, and an examination processing fee. OBMI anticipates additional revenues of \$31,500 in 2019-21 and \$43,500 in 2021-23.

OBMI expenditures are anticipated to increase \$17,500 in 2019-21. Permittees will pay OBMI an examination fee to take a licensing examination to qualify for this permit. OBMI is then invoiced for these funds by the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists, which administers the exam.

Additional duties related to administration of this new permit will be absorbed by current agency staff and resources.
