As an Executive Director for SPOKES Unlimited from Klamath Falls, I Curtis Raines am writing to you to speak out in support of House Bill 3122:

Requires Department of Human Services to request in agency request budget and Governor to include in Governor's budget specified amount of General Fund moneys for distribution to centers for independent living.

Centers for Independent Living (CILs) in Oregon play a critical role in empowering people with disabilities to find a voice and to advocate for resources to meet their needs. Access to CIL peer counselors is a unique resource not available at other safety net service agencies. People with disabilities find their voices at CILs!

We need robust CIL peer counseling services across Oregon for our agency and state services to be successful. CILs provide a foundation for accessing services.
