

The deer- and elk-vehicle collision data used to calculate the collision density were supplied by the Oregon Department of Transportation maintenance dispatch. The records date from September 2009 through December 2017. The density (in collisions per mile) is the quotient of the number of struck animals reported within a 1 mile radius and the calculated mileage of state highways residing within that same radius overlain on the state highway system.
