I want to express my opposition to Senate Bill 111.

I grow 15 acres of wine grapes in Clackamas County.

I am opposed to this bill for the following reasons:

- SB111 creates new standards that are confusing and unnecessary.
- SB111 creates an unfair playing field where some large growers are winners and many large and small growers are losers.
- SB111 pinches the market and creating a market to increase the price of some grapes and lower the price of virtually all others.
- Sections 3-4-5 of the bill are retaliatory and will divide the industry. The 2025 deadline to create a reciprocal agreements is not necessary and has a low probably of success. Section 8 (a cumbersome new mechanism to collect the tax) creates an unfair, non level playing ground where OWA members benefit at the destruction of everyone else.
- . It benefits large growers at the expense of smaller ones.
